The chart is a tree structure starting from a single individual (1) at the bottom left. It branches upwards through five generations. Each generation contains a box for recording vital events: Birth Date and Place, Marriage Date and Place, and Death Date and Place. Generation 1 (Individual 1): Includes fields for BIRTH DATE AND PLACE, MARRIAGE DATE AND PLACE, DEATH DATE AND PLACE, and SPOUSE.

Generation 2 (Individuals 2, 3): Individual 2 includes fields for BIRTH DATE AND PLACE, MARRIAGE DATE AND PLACE, and DEATH DATE AND PLACE. Individual 3 includes fields for BIRTH DATE AND PLACE and DEATH DATE AND PLACE.

Generation 3 (Individuals 4, 5, 6, 7): Each of these four boxes includes fields for BIRTH DATE AND PLACE, MARRIAGE DATE AND PLACE, and DEATH DATE AND PLACE.

Generation 4 (Individuals 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15): Each of these eight boxes includes fields for BIRTH DATE AND PLACE, MARRIAGE DATE AND PLACE, and DEATH DATE AND PLACE.

Generation 5 (Individuals 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31): Each of these sixteen boxes includes fields for BIRTH DATE AND PLACE, MARRIAGE DATE AND PLACE, and DEATH DATE AND PLACE.
