As in the past, we will have social time at 6:30pm with our short business meeting at 7:00pm and our program will begin after the meeting. Tuesday 10 September 2024 - "Down on the Farm: Geauga County Farm Life 1958" with Dan Best, retired GCPD naturalist. He will tell the story of a fictional farm family, learn about dairy farming, maple sugaring, teen past times and more.

Tuesday 8 October 2024 - "Magical, Mercurial, Mysterious Cousin Anna" - with retired GCPL genealogist Cheryl McClellan as she tries to solve Cousin Anna's mysteries which continue to unfold thirty years after her passing. Learn how to find and preserve the legends on your family tree.

Tuesday 12 November 2024 - "Honor to our Deceased Veterans" - presented by our own GCGS members Cathy and Rob Schwind. They discovered graves of five forgotten veterans when they restored a pioneer cemetery. Since 2021, as part of a national program, "Wreaths Across America", they have documented over 860 veterans buried at Evergreen Hill Cemetery in Chagrin Falls, OH. Their goal is to have no veteran forgotten who is buried there. Come and listen to their story and learn ways to honor your own deceased veterans.
